TWO MATHEW STRICKLANDS

by L. C. Strickland

There is some published research on our Strickland Genealogy that does not provide sufficient evidence to support the claims made. Principally, the research that I include in this article is that of Worth S. Ray Research Collection, 975 DAR, Vol. 31, page 16. Quote, "Matthew Strickland, Sr. who married Elizabeth Loreen, of Liverpool, England and came to Maryland in 1679 on the HERRON. August 4, 1699 his land was divided between his sons." End of quote.

First, I would like to say that the land division between sons of Mathew Strickland, referred to above, occurred in Isle of Wight County, Virginia, and is published by John Bennett Boddie in his book, SEVENTEENTH CENTURY ISLE OF WIGHT COUNTY, VIRGINIA, and has the following paragraph taken from the County Deed Book I: "Mathew Strickland and William Strickland, sons of Mathew Strickland, deceased, have made a division of their lands. Mathew gives his brother, Samuel Strickland, 150 acres and his brother, John Strickland, 150 acres and to his brothers, William and Joseph, 150 acres apiece, 4 August 1699. Barnaby Mackinney, Thomas Marks."

Secondly, upon examination of the document mentioned in the first paragraph of this article from the Worth S. Ray Collection, it will be observed that one person came on the Heron in the year of 1678, that six persons came on the Heron in the year of 1679, and two persons, namely a Matthew Strickland and Elizabeth Loreen, came on the GLOBE in the year of 1680. Please note that the ship these two persons came on was the GLOBE and not the HERON, and that the year was 1680. Also note that this warrant granted to John Tanner, Merchant, four hundred and fifty acres of land to him for the importation of the named persons in the document. Consequently, these persons came under bond, or at the expense of someone else; namely, John Tanner.

In a second document, which may be found in the Calvert County, Maryland, Testamentary Proceedings, Vol. 16, pages 30 and 31, the following is recorded: Thomas Greenfield came into Court November 1691, Calvert County, Maryland, and requested Letters of Administration of goods and possessions of Mathew Strickland, late of Calvert County, deceased, who died intestate. Whereupon this Thomas Greenfield was directed to give an inventory accounting within three months. (Editor's Note: Photocopies of the original documents referred to in this article are in the Strickland Library Document File. They are negative photocopies, and will not reproduce clear enough to print in the quarterly. NJC)

At this point, I introduce evidence which I believe supports the theory that another Mathew Strickland, at an earlier date, 1678, was already on the scene in the Isle of Wight County, Virginia; involved in receiving a land grant of 902 acres of land for the transportation of 18 persons; date of this document 26 September 1678, recorded in Patent Book No. 6, page 653. Then again, this same Mathew Strickland received 1,803 acres of land for the transporta-

tion of 36 persons, Book No. 7, page 20, dated 20 April 1680. I must acknowledge at this point that we have not determined how and precisely the date this Mathew Strickland came to this land. Here is a question I pose at this time, would a person place himself in bond to travel to this land during the Colonial Period when he had the means to pay for the transportation of 54 persons? This is what Mathew Strickland did in the Isle of Wight County, Virginia.

To summarize, based upon data and documentations currently available, one would have to conclude that the Matthew Strickland of Calvert County, Maryland, whose possessions were inventoried by Thomas Greenfield, as directed by the November 1691 Court, died prior to this date. Also, I would point out that these are all of the records on the Strickland Family that are located in the Hall Records, Annapolis, Maryland, according to the authorities there, and that these documents do not reveal any heirs of this Matthew Strickland. It cannot be concluded that he did or did not have heirs. There is no document to indicate that he did or did not have wife or children. Many records were destroyed by fire in Calvert County, in 1882. It is my opinion that the Matthew Strickland of Calvert County, Maryland, and the Mathew Strickland of the Isle of Wight County, Virginia were different men. It is reported in "GONE TO GEORGIA", by William C. Stewart, that Mathew Strickland Sr., Isle of Wight County, Virginia, died 1696, which would have been five years after the death of the Maryland Matthew Strickland.

Now, to further muddle the situation, read some recently published data on our Stricklands of Virginia. BUCHANAN, VIRGINIA, GATEWAY TO THE SOUTHWEST by Harry Fulwiler, Jr., 1980, pages 835-839, herein partially quoted. "William Strickland, an early settler of Botentourt, was probably descended from Roger Strickland and his wife, Elizabeth Loreen, of Moreland County, Westmoreland, England. The name was originally Stirkland; Stirks were later called Steers. Leaving a long settled place of residence, this couple left England in 1679, sailed to the Colonies on a ship called the 'Herron'." Poor Elizabeth! How many Strickland husbands did she have?

FREDERICK HASTINGS STRICKLAND, lumberman, was born in Bangor, Maine, on Sept. 9, 1856, the son of WM. HASTINGS & CLARA (LEIGHTON) STRICKLAND. He was educated at Highland Military Academy in Worcester, Mass.; and married CHARLOTTE COOMBS on Dec. 9, 1885. He served as a member of the Maine House of Representatives 3 terms; was a Lt. Col. in WWI; and member of the Governor's staff 1881-83. He died September 16, 1939.

The following information was abstracted from HISTORY OF PORTAGE COUNTY, OHIO, ILLUSTRATED 1885, printed originally by Warner, Beers & Co., 1885; reprinted by The Portage County Historical Society, Inc., Ravenna, Ohio, 1972.

page 454: Section about Freedom Township. The first frame house was put up by Paul Larkcom in 1826 for DANIEL W. STRICKLAND on Lot 46.

page 455: In 1837, the first steam saw-mill was erected at Drakesburg by D. W. STRICKLAND, but it was burned to the ground the following year.

The first church society in the township was organized Feb. 9, 1828, at the house of A. C. Larkcom, by Revs. Joseph Treat and David L. Coe, members of the Presbytery of Portage County and was composed of the following...D. W. STRICKLAND and wife...D. W. STRICKLAND was elected Clerk.

page 951-952: WILLIS STRICKLAND, retired farmer, born June 10, 1801, in Sandisfield, Berkshire Co., Mass...at age of 14 went with his father's family to Otis, Berkshire Co., where he lived till he came to Ohio. In 1827, he married Miss Lucy Hawley, and in June, 1839, came to Windham Township, this county, where Mrs. Strickland died in January 1841, leaving 3 children: SETH, in Minnesota; SELAH, in Wisconsin; and LUCY H. who died at the age of 24. Our subject next married, in June, 1841, Mrs. Caroline Gardner, of New Lebanon, NY, and came to his home in this county. To this union were born 3 children: GEORGE, a farmer in Ravenna; JOHN, died age 16; WILLIS, killed at age 16 by a kick from a horse in 1875. This wife dying in January, 1866, Mr. STRICKLAND married November 27, 1875, Mrs. Sarah E. Richards, who had at that time one daughter - Alice, now the wife of Milton R. Furry of Ravenna. Mr. STRICKLAND moved to Ravenna in April, 1855. Mr. STRICKLAND has been very successful a farmer and business man, devoting himself principally to livestock. He was active in public affairs up to 1855, and while in Massachusetts was called to various public offices, including Postmaster and Representative in the Legislature. In July, 1875, he in company with N. D. Clark, went to Dakota, taking \$125,000 in Northern Pacific Railroad bonds owned by themselves and other citizens of Portage County, where they were exchanged for land in Cass County, which proved to be a good investment for the bond-holders in Windham Township, this county. He was twice elected Justice of the Peace. He is now and has been for the last twenty years a stockholder and one of the Directors in the First National Bank of Ravenna, Ohio. Mrs. STRICKLAND is a member of the Disciples Church.

page 923: In the biography of Henry B. WALDEN is this statement, "To our subject's parents were born 2 children: Caroline, deceased wife of SETH STRICKLAND.

page 923: On coming to Windham, Thomas J. Woodworth bought Lot 33, then known as the WILLIS STRICKLAND, 1860.

JESSE STRICKLIN (STRICKLANG) was a Private in Captain Thomas Boykin's Company, Major Cameron's Command, of the North Carolina Drafted Militia. He was drafted for six months service. A Company Pay Roll shows he was paid for duty from July 24, 1813 to September 20, 1813. His pay per month was eight dollars. A Company Muster Roll, dated September 26, 1813, states he was "Discharged by Substitute, September 20, 1813."

Georgia:

ALLEN STRICKLAND enlisted as a 2 Sergeant in Captain Lewis Easter's Company of Infantry, 3rd Regiment, Georgia Militia, on November 21, 1814. He was stationed at Camp Darien, Georgia, and is listed on a Company Pay Roll, dated November 21, 1814 to March 8, 1815, and on a Company Muster Roll dated December 8, 1814 to March 8, 1815. His residence is given as Clinton, Jones County, Georgia, 200 miles from Darien. His pay per month was \$11.

ALLEN STRICKLAND received a pension while living in Desota County, Mississippi. He appeared in Probate Court on the 6th of June 1851 to declare his eligibility for a pension. Among the papers in his file is the following certification of service:
