EDITOR'S LETTER

Dear Members,

Let me begin by apologizing for not contacting you and letting you know there still is a Strickland organization. I feel I owe each of you an explanation as well as an apology.

Other than my family, I have had 3 primary interests. My first interest has always been the Strickland organization; the 2nd, the history of the individuals who lived in Campbell County GA; and 3rd, the Confederate history of Georgia. I have devoted many years to these subjects; however, after all these years of being able to schedule my time exactly as I felt it should be, I was abruptly and rudely awakened to the fact that my time was no longer my own, and . . . I had to shelve all of my interests in order for my husband and I to continue "eating". Suddenly, "eating" became a bit more important than any other interest I might have.

The day before Thanksgiving, 1986, the company for which my husband had worked for 20+ years closed its doors and declared bankruptcy. At that point Phil could have begun searching for other employment. Instead we decided to go into business for ourselves. In June 1987 we opened our business - GraphicSouth - an art and typesetting business supplying pre-press work to printers. Since that time it has been an uphill struggle to establish ourselves as a quality studio. We are working 12 to 16 hours a day, 6 and 7 days a week, with time off for meals!

In the meantime, both our daughters have married and our son lost his wife to cancer. There have been other ups and downs - too many to recite, but these I hope are enough to support my plea of temporary incapacity, "insanity", or whatever!

With much help from Robert Stricklin (who has agreed to assist editing Strickland Scene), we are publishing and mailing our quarterly again. Bear with us, and soon we all will have our organization on the right track.

Many of you sent checks that at the time I did not deposit. Since everything was up in the air I felt it best to hold them until something could be worked out - not expecting it would be so long. For now older checks (1987-88) are being returned. I hope each of you whose checks now are returned will resubmit them (or send another) so we may begin anew - and this time they will be deposited.

I sincerely hope you will understand the strain I have felt for the past couple of years and that you will elect to stay with the Strickland organization. We cannot promise you will always receive your quarterlies on time, but we can promise they will eventually get to you.

Thank you for your patience and understanding. If you have any suggestions or if you can volunteer some time, please let us know.

MISCELLANEOUS STRICKLAND RECORDS FROM AUSTRALIA

Philip STRICKLAND/STICKLAND was transported to Australia on the "Calcutta" in 1803 for stealing a sheep from Thomas WHITE of Corfe Mullen, County Dorset, England.

***Anne Marie STICKLAND (1797-1856) m. 1818 John WARLAND (1797-1865).

Sarah STRICKLAND (-1821) m. 1783 Robert WARLAND (1759-1821), John and Robert being cousins.

William STRICKLAND, d. 27 Jun 1866 at age 56 or 66 years; buried at Camperdown Cemetery, Sydney, N.S.W.

Edward Herbert STRICKLAND, d. 17 Dec 1809 or 1869 at age 9 yrs 6 days; buried at Camperdown, the headstone is worn and age and year are difficult to decipher.

THE FAMILY OF ELLIS & KATHERINE WITTE STRICKLAND

This item from a 1966 letter to her grandmother is shared by Betty PONTING:

"Grandpa Strickland's name was Ellis STRICKLAND. Grandma's was Katherine WITTE.

"Great Grandpa WITTE was Denis, and great grandma was Constance (JOHNSON) WITTE. Home in Nelson County, Virginia, but West Virginia now. [Nelson Co adjoins Augusta and Rockbridge Cos VA - ed.] Our dad was born in old Virginia, near Richmond. Our dad had two brothers killed on Confederate side in Civil War, then Uncle Dave that lived at Springfield, Missouri. His oldest daughter, Rose, married a BESHEAR. Her boy did live on Eskew Street, Kansas City, not too far from Bessie's, his wife worked at Sears. These WITTS here in this County are our dad's cousins. He came over here to see them once.

"Flora's mother had 2 sisters, Lizzie and Hannah. They married brothers, ILLICKs, one had, I think, 5 children, the other none and she took Cy and raised him. Then when they died, he was 15, he came out here and lived with us, when Vernie was a little baby. Those boys live at Carthage, Missouri, now I expect. One was George ILLICK.

"John STRICKLAND, born July 14, 1837, died January 24, 1908, buried Rothville, Missouri. Married to Mary L. (Polly) MELTON on February 17, 1867. She was born October 8, 1842, died February 28, 1877, buried near Edinburg, Illinois. 5 children born to this union.

"John Alexander STRICKLAND, born November 21, 1867, died _____, buried Brookfield, Missouri.

"Ullysses Grant STRICKLAND, born December 4, 1869, died November 20, 1940, buried Rothville, Missouri.

"Nellie Catherine STRICKLAND STAPLES, born August 23, 1871, died May, 1954, Brookfield, Missouri.

"Flora Belle STRICKLAND SHOEMAKER, born July 23, 1873, died March 20, 1957, Sumner, Missouri.

"Josiah Hill STRICKLAND, born November, 1876, died March 26, 1938, Floral Hills, Kansas City.

"John STRICKLAND married December 15, 1877, second marriage, to Elizabeth Jane ADAMS, born December 15, 1850, died March 24, 1912, buried at Rothville, Missouri. To this union 5 children were born.

"Manley STRICKLAND born August 8, 1878, died January 23, 1925, buried at Rothville, Missouri.

"Ada STRICKLAND BRAMMER, born October 30, 1879,

"Harry STRICKLAND, born November 7, 1883, died April 22, 1943, buried Brookfield, Missouri.

"Newton Lewis STRICKLAND, born March 2, 1887, died June 21, 1950, buried Butte, Montana.

"Myrtle STRICKLAND GABLE, born January 31, 1889,

"About all I know, the first two paragraphs is what our cousin, Katie DUFFIELD, wrote to me a long time ago. She is near Myrtle's age and lives in mountains of West Virginia.

POSEY, clerk, married 10 Apr 1828 by James FERGUSON, J.P., filed 20 May 1828; an affidavit dated 5 Apr 1828 by Willis STRICKLAND stated that Catherine SLOANE was 18 years of age and to the best of his knowledge and belief there was no legal impediment or objection to her union in matrimony with William STRICKLAND, both of Gallatin Co IL;

John STANOFORD & Nancy STRIPLIN, license issued 24 Nov 1829 by J. CALDWELL, clerk, married same date by Francis GEHON, J.P.
